
This incredibly simple image depicts the king Amerykański, terrified after a battle.

At the beginning, let me tell you a few words about the Delorean Motor Company. The creator of the car was the American entrepreneur John DeLorean. The only car produced by him was DeLorean DMC-12. It was designed by the Italian designer Giorgetto Giugiaro and was produced for two years. It had a trunk in front and Gull-wing doors. Unfortunately, the car wasn't a big success in those times. It was due to high costs of production and technical issues. In 1982 the company collapsed.

The company and its owner would have been forgotten, but a miracle happened. The car was used as a base for the time machine from the trilogy "Back To The Future". Thanks to that, DeLorean has been popular and nostalgic to these days.

## "Music in difficult times"

On 2nd May the premiere of a new version of the song "2Step" by Ed Sheeran took place. This time the artist appeared with the Ukrainian band Antytila, whose musicians are currently fighting. Nevertheless, they managed to write a text and record their parts. The music video was also created. Antytila is one of the most popular Ukrainian bands. After the outbreak of the war, they released an album, now they are very involved in helping their country. When they heard about a charity concert in Birmingham, they immediately reported to take part, remotely, straight from the defended Kiev. Ed Sheeran submitted a similar proposal on Tiktok. Although finally the concert organizers did not agree to their occurrence, to avoid military connections, Ed Sheeran spoke to them with a proposal for cooperation. Topolia the frontman of the band in the new words of the song "2step" says how the war began for him and his relatives and for millions of Ukrainians. Working in the recording studio in Hostomel, in which they usually worked, was not available because of the occupation. However, they found others, and the ready material returned the Sheeran team in just two weeks from the moment of receiving the cooperation proposal. Then, a video clip was partly made in Kiev and on the road to Kharkov, using a GoPro camera. It lasted only 15 minutes. The music video on YouTube was watched by over 1.5 million users within two days. Over the next year, profits from the views will be forwarded to power the account of the Music Saves UA initiative, supporting Ukrainian civilians injured by the war.

## AMERICAN DREAM



#### Dog sports exist!

However, I'd like to concentrate on dogfrisbee.

Disc dog, commonly called dogfrisbee is a dog sport that involves throwing a plastic disc by a human and catching the disc by a dog. The dog should be fast, focused and well motivated. Human must have a good throwing technique to make the disc fly far and straight.

Probably, many of you are wondering how to start your adventure with disc dog. It's very easy! All that is necessary to try it, is a large area, a dog and a flying disc (you can buy them on the Internet).

In the beginning, you need to practise throwing the disc. If you learn to throw well, the dog will catch the disc. But if the dog doesn't want to catch the disc, you should go to a trainer who will help you solve the problem. There are several dogfrisbee trainers in Poland. There are also many courses on the Internet "How to start training dogfrisbee?". This should help!

Dogfrisbee competitions are organized several times all over the world. In Poland, it usually takes place in a large city such as Warsaw, Wrocław or Gdańsk. The competition is divided into a few disciplines. For example, Frizglity is the discipline in which the dog has to overcome three obstacles and catch the disc. Another interesting discipline is freestyle. It consists of making a set of various figures and throwing techniques. The music sets the rhythm to the whole performance, which is limited in time to two minutes. The handler must create a good team and connection with dog.

He lived in the second half of the 19th century. His mother dreamt of him becoming a doctor, but he enrolled at the University of Warsaw at the Faculty of Law, Philosophy and History. However, he did not complete his studies and began working as an editor. He started his work

with journalism, literary and historical sketches and short stories

that responded to problems at his homeland and abroad.

He travelled a lot. The evidence of his travels are his letters. He sent not only correspondence, but also novels from different places of his stay. After returning to Poland (at the age of 35), he married Maria Szetkiewiczówna. He had 3 wives and each of them was named Maria. They were Maria Babska, Maria Romanowska, Maria Szetkiewicz.

Sienkiewicz became famous mainly as the author of historical novels: Ogniem i mieczem, Potop, Pan Wołodyjowski, Quo Vadis, Krzyżacy and W pustyni i w puszczy.

Sienkiewicz is one of the most popular Polish writers in the world.

What does he draw in it when the cameras are not looking at him?


Can writing a diary get a man sent to prison?



# The story of a young officer




## Two women, two faces

What comes to your mind when you hear the name Jane Austen? Have you ever heard of the book 'Sense and Sensibility'?

Jane Austen was born in 1775 in Hampshire. She never married. She accepted one marriage proposal, but changed her mind the next day. She never wrote about the Napoleonic Wars or the French Revolution, but about romance and matchmaking. Her novels have been enduringly popular since her first book was published.

The book 'Sense and Sensibility' is about two sisters who do not quite look like sisters. The first is Elinor, who is calm and beautiful.
